

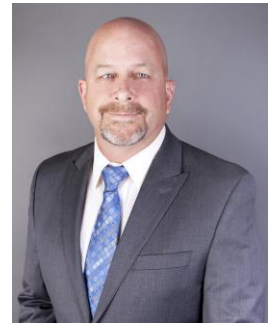

The overall project will also include the realignment of Second Street between O and P Streets, additional parking areas, relocated service docks, and a paved courtyard. In addition, some of the existing buildings will be re-modeled and the Herold Wing will be replaced with a new structure.
